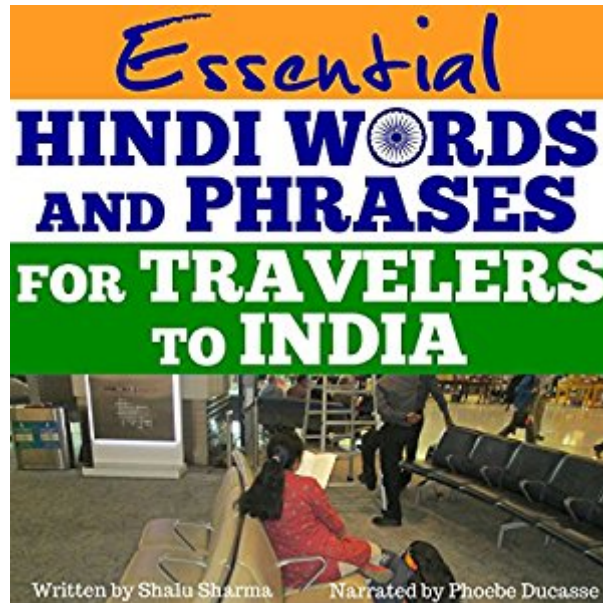

The author provides a cursory introduction to the history and development of the Hindi language, as well as quick tips (conveniently provided throughout the text) as to formal and familiar greetings and subtle phrasings in pronunciation. There is also a map that shows where the Hindi language predominates in specific regions of the country. From there we are introduced to the most commonly used words in everyday situations, such as greetings, dining and lodging, asking for directions and making it around the marketplace. This is not going to get you through an extended conversation, but at least

you'll be able to let someone know what you're looking for and get steered in the right direction.
